CAMP LOTTA-FUN

Children are required to be 3 yrs. old by Aug. 31st, 2024, and toilet trained to enroll in our Camp Lotta-Fun summer program. Children turning 3 yrs. on or after Sept. 1 may enroll in our Fall 2.5 Jumpstart program.
