Getting Acquainted; "Sleepy Line Across" Writing Stroke

Getting acquainted and becoming familiar with our school environment will be our main goal for the first two weeks. We will discuss classroom rules and become familiar with our daily schedule. <u>Please bring a recent snapshot of your child and a family photo that we can use in a class book</u>. We would appreciate these as soon as possible.

<u>Owls; "Short Line Down and Tall Line Down" Writing Stroke</u> We will spend this week learning about our classroom bird! What do owls like to eat, where they live, and how do they live?

All About Me; "Leaning Line and Tall Leaning Line" Writing Stroke

We will continue to get to know our classmates and teachers through an "All About Me" theme. We will learn about everyone's family, interests, and favorites. Have your child bring **3** of their favorite things to school in a sealed bag, objects that represent them, and/or family photos that they can show our class this week. Each child will share information about these "favorites" and answer questions their classmates may have. However, to keep the spread of germs to a minimum, we will not be passing them around the class.

Sept. 27- Oct.1Community and Classroom Safety; "Circle and Tall Circle" StrokeThis week will be all about fire safety and keeping ourselves safe. We'll discuss "stranger
danger", and what we should do if someone is lost or hurt.

OWL FOLDERS

One pocket of the folder will be labeled "Home" for important information that you can keep at home and the other pocket will be labeled "Return" for important information that needs to be returned to school. Themes/Numbers/Letters/Sight Words – In September, our class will have a theme each week and the letter stroke we will be introducing. Beginning in October, we'll include a number, letter, and sight word each week.
