CANARY NEWS

The Canary classroom has been a hubbub of activity during September. For many children this is a first experience in a preschool setting, so there is much excitement, stimulation and even a little hesitation. Our focus during this time has been "getting acquainted" with our school community. This has involved getting to know classmates and families in our room, the teachers, routines, and rules of school plus the outdoor environment. Along with getting acquainted comes the territory of increasing independence. We have been promoting restroom skills, using words to make needs known, learning to share and separating from parents for extended periods.

A DAY IN THE CANARY CLASS

Our "circle times", while short in length, work on long term skills. Conversations and listening skills are practiced along with "following directions." We work on these areas through music and song, movement, storytelling and group discussion. The Canaries love to listen to stories and songs. Some of their favorites are "The Welcome Song" "Waiting for the Elevator" and "The Freeze Dance".

Our lunchtime experience is very social. A strong emphasis is placed on sitting appropriately along with polite social behavior and conversation at the lunch table, while we have fun learning about one another.

The Canaries are quite interested dramatic play, building and many other free play activities. One of our present goals, as teachers, is to spend time playing with the children. We can become more familiar with the children during this activity, as well as model positive behavior such as sharing, taking tuns, treating others and property with respect and cleaning up.
