We are getting acquainted very nicely in the Robin room. The children have been busy making new friends, learning classroom rules, settling into our Robin routine, and best of all...having lots of fun together! Our classroom is filled with active, happy children! The focus in September was listening and following directions. We will continue to reinforce and practice these skills with all the children in large and small group settings. We will also continue working on "self-help" skills such as toileting, hand washing, putting on their own jackets and unpacking their lunchboxes.

We wrapped up September with a visit from the fire department on Sept. 23<sup>rd</sup>. We'll have a practice fire drill at school to learn what we do in case of a fire. Ask your child to demonstrate "stop, drop and roll." Don't forget to double check your smoke detectors (changing the batteries with the daylight savings time change is an easy way to remember). Be sure to practice a family fire drill and set up a safe meeting place plan.
